












PROPHET KARL WALLENDA

MICHAEL G. WAHL, PGM, 33° GRAND HISTORIAN



As far back as 1780, in the cafes of Old Bohemia in the Austro-Hungarian Empire, the ancestral Wallenda family was a traveling circus troupe consisting of acrobats, jugglers, clowns, aerialists and animal trainers all in one family.

They traveled through the villages of Europe setting up and performing in the

city squares, trusting in their talent and skills to provoke thrills and joy, relying on the generosity of the audience to reward them as they passed the hat around. In the late 1800s, for the next two generations, they became known for their expertise in the art of flying trapeze.

Karl Wallenda was born in Magdeburg, Germany, in 1905. He was performing in the family show at age six and doing stunts in beer halls at age eleven. His feature was stacking several chairs and doing a handstand on the top chair. In the early 1920s, he answered an ad in a trade paper for "an experienced hand balancer with courage." The job consisted of following behind a wire-walker, out to the middle of the wire and doing a handstand on the man's feet as he lay down on the cable. In 1922 Karl developed his own act, recruiting his brother Herman, an aerialist named Josef Geiger, and a teenage girl, Helen Kreis, who would eventually become Karl's wife.

The act toured Europe for several years and featured an amazing 4-person, 3-level pyramid. Karl precariously balanced on a chair on top of a bar between the shoulders of the two men who were on bicycles on a wire 50 feet in the air while Helen would stand on Karl's shoulders! This act was such a sensation that when John Ringling saw them performing in Cuba, he immediately contracted them to appear with the "Greatest Show On Earth." When the Great Wallendas debuted their act (without a net - it had been misplaced in shipping) at Madison Square Garden in 1928, they received a standing ovation that lasted 15 minutes! Never before or to date has applause stopped a performance for that length of time.

The Great Wallendas were headliners with Ringling Brothers, Barnum & Bailey Circus during much of the 1930s and 1940s. In 1947 Karl began to build a circus of his own. At the Wallenda's Sarasota, Florida, home that winter, he also created his crowning achievement—the seven-person chair pyramid. Four men stood on a wire 35 feet in the air, two

pairs yoked together by shoulder bars. On top of them on the second level stood two more men, again yoked together with a shoulder bar. At the pinnacle of this pyramid was a woman sitting and then standing on a chair! This trick was successfully performed from 1948 through 1962 by the Wallendas with an occasional change of family members and varying conditions, including surviving an earthquake in South America. After a catastrophic fall in Detroit the Seven was only done again on two subsequent occasions: In 1963, to prove that life does continue and that disaster does not have to end in defeat, and again in 1977, recreated primarily by Karl's grandchildren for the movie *The Great Wallendas*.

Karl was a member of Al Sirat Grotto in Cleveland and became a good friend with many other Grottoes throughout the Realm by helping them organize circus performances to raise funds for Grotto projects. Karl is pictured below with Prophets from Aries Grotto during one of his circus programs in Detroit.

Karl continued performing as the feature performer with a smaller troupe and became increasingly popular doing "Sky Walks," walking between buildings and across stadiums, including Busch, Veterans, JFK, 3 Rivers Stadiums and the Astrodome, among others. His most famous walk was a 1200-foot long trek across the Tallulah Falls Gorge in Georgia, where 30,000 people watched as this 65-year-old legend performed two separate headstands at a height of over 700 feet in the air.

It was during a promotional walk in San Juan, Puerto Rico, in March, 1978, that the patriarch of the Great Wallendas fell to his death at age 73. Not because of his age or capabilities, not because of the wind, but because of several misconnected guy ropes along the wire. Karl once said, "Life is being on the wire, everything else is just waiting." The Wallenda legacy lives on to the sixth and seventh generations through Karl's grandchildren and great-grandchildren.



RETENTION! —

Suspending a Prophet for non-payment of dues is a sad moment in the life of any Grotto. Unfortunately, it is a necessary part of maintaining the integrity and financial health of the Realm. It is also an opportunity to maybe learn something about your Grotto, or even get the Prophet active again. The ideal situation is of course never allowing it to get to that point. Let me share a few thoughts on steps that can be taken to possibly prevent an NPD suspension.

There was a woman in the church I grew up in named Esther. Esther would sit in the back of the sanctuary every Sunday and look at who was present. She knew almost every single member of the congregation. If someone was missing for two weeks in a row, the name was passed on to the pastor for follow-up. It was a great way to make sure people knew they were cared about.

Does your Grotto have someone like Esther? Is there a Prophet who knows who is missing? It could be a job for the Sentinel or Captain of the Guard. Let the Monarch know who is missing so he can send an email or note. Even better, he can make a phone call or a visit to find out what is happening in the Prophet's life. He might have just had a couple of conflicting events in a row or maybe it is something more. You will never know unless you contact him.

Another person who is important in the retention process is the sponsor. So often a Prophet is excited to recruit a new Prophet. But what happens at the second meeting? Does the sponsoring Prophet help the newly initiated Prophet become a part of the Grotto? Does he make sure he is developing a love of Grotto? This is the first step in preventing an NPD suspension.

If it comes to the point where you are prepared to suspend a Prophet, please speak to him first. Do not just send him a letter or an email. Have someone, preferably the Monarch, or the Membership and/or Suspension Chairman, talk to him about the Grotto. Why is he not paying his dues? Is it because his expectations were not being met? Is it due to financial hardship? We ought to know if there is something we can do to keep him as a part of the Realm. If not, we can use what we learned to keep the same situation from happening to another Prophet.

Retention happens one Prophet at a time. Retention happens when the Grotto is important to a Prophet and a Prophet is important to the Grotto. Do everything you can to let your fellow Prophets know how important they are to you and your Grotto.

"Not only are they attesting to their organizations' adherence to sound standards, they are helping to increase donor confidence and strengthen public trust in giving."



ATTENTION MONARCHS! RED TASSLE BYLAW CHANGE

Don't forget that at the 123rd Annual Session, Article V Sessions was amended to allow three (3) Red Tassel Prophets, named by the Monarch, eligible to vote at the Annual Sessions. In order for them to vote you must notify the Supreme Council office, in writing, (forms will be mailed mid-March) the names and Supreme Council number of the three (3) Red Tassel Prophets eligible to vote. In no circumstance will a Red Tassel Prophet be allowed to vote unless this notification is received with the Secretary's Attestation by the SC office by the set deadline of *April 25, 2014*. As a reminder, these Prophets are *not* entitled to Supreme Council mileage and per diem.

ARTICLE V SESSIONS

- 5a. The Supreme Council shall meet annually at such time and place as may be designated by its Bylaws, and General Regulations.
- **5b.** Special sessions may be called by the Grand Monarch.
- **5c.** No business other than that specified in the call shall be transacted at special sessions.

Those entitled to vote at a Supreme Council Session consist of all Past Monarchs of Grottoes in attendance (including at Large) and incumbent Monarchs, Chief Justices, Master of Ceremonies and Secretaries, or their alternates. No man may have more than one vote which he must cast in person, except if a Past Monarch is named as alternate for an incumbent Monarch, Chief Justice, Master of Ceremonies, or Secretary, he has his own vote as Past Monarch and the vote of the officer for whom he has been appointed alternate. (J. & L., 1952)

5d. Entitled to Vote at an annual session of the Supreme Council shall include all Past Monarchs in attendance and incumbent Monarch, Chief Justice, Master of Ceremonies and Secretary of their Grotto or their alternate. In addition to those, there shall be an additional three (3) Red Tassel Prophets from each Grotto named by the Monarch sixty days prior to each session and whom shall not be entitled to any Supreme Council mileage and per diem.

Please note that you cannot vote unless the SC office has received, 60 days prior to convention, your eligibility to vote form.

NOTICE TO PROPHETS

Each year at the Supreme Council National Convention four (4) management positions are available. Three (3) of these positions - the Grand Captain of the Guard, Grand Treasurer and a Grand Trustee are elected on the floor at the convention and are open to Monarchs and Past Monarchs only. The fourth position (Humanitarian Foundation Trustee) is appointed by the Board of Governors during the convention and is available to Past Monarchs and Monarchs.

1. GRAND CAPTAIN OF THE GUARD

The entry level position in the Grand Line. Duties are to guard the Supreme Council while in session and comply with all wishes of the Grand Monarch. This office should be completely familiar with the Supreme Council Code and be prepared to accept more responsibilities as he progresses through the Supreme Council Line to his ultimate goal of Grand Monarch. He is a voting member of the Supreme Council Board of Governors. He is paid mileage/per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses for Board Meetings.

2. GRAND TREASURER

Elected for one (1) year term. Duties and responsibilities are outlined in Chapter V, Section 5.6 of the Supreme Council Code. This officer

is also a voting member of the Board of Governors as outlined in Chapter VI of the Supreme Council Code. He is paid mileage/per diem for attendance at the National Convention and actual expenses for attendance at other Board Meetings. Preferably, he should have a financial management background.

3. GRAND TRUSTEE

Elected for a three (3) year term. Duties and responsibilities involve the management of property and investing of Supreme Council funds as outlined in Chapter V, Section 5.11, 5.12 and 5.14 of the Supreme Council Code. He should be experienced in financial investing. He is paid mileage/per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses if ever to attend Board of Governors meetings.

4. HUMANITARIAN FOUNDATION TRUSTEE

This is a position appointed by the Supreme Council Board of Governors for a five (5) year term. For details of the duties and responsibilities of this position refer to Chapter X of the Supreme Council Code. Prophets interested in this position should submit a brief resume of their qualifications to the Supreme Council Board of Governors through the Supreme Council Office. Remuneration is the same as a Grand Trustee.
