





MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMS

VIP PROGRAM

Any Prophet who sponsors a new member or reinstated member who has been out of the Grotto for at least 13 months between May 1 and April 30 will be awarded a VIP pin and card and is entitled to attend the Grand Monarch's VIP breakfast at the Supreme Council Convention in Louisville, Kentucky.

SLEEP ON US

The first (10) ten Prophets sponsoring 10 new or qualified reinstated Prophets between May 1st and April 30 will receive one (1) FREE night stay in the convention host hotel during the Supreme Council Session. The first Prophet to sponsor twenty-five (25) new Prophets will receive four (4) free nights at host hotel.

KEY PROPHETS

Any Prophet sponsoring 3 new or qualified reinstated members between May 1st and April 30th will be awarded a distinctive GOLD Key emblem. Any Prophet sponsoring 5 new members will receive a RUBY Key and for 7 or more new members a DIAMOND Key. A Prophet will receive one (1) key of the Highest level he has earned. If in attendance at the Supreme Council Session, the key will be presented by the Grand Monarch.

MASTER MASON NIGHTS

The Supreme Council will reimburse a Grotto 50% of the cost, up to \$300.00 for a Master Mason night once a year. Contact the Supreme Council Office for details and a REGISTRATION FORM. Pre-approval of the event must be obtained.

RECRUITER OF THE MONTH

The Prophet sponsoring the greatest number of new members initiated in the entire Realm in any month, with a minimum of two (2), will receive a \$100.00 cash award. The initiation report must be turned in to Supreme Council office by the close of the following month. Awards will be split if a tie occurs.

We will reimburse a Grotto up to \$75.00 for attending and providing refreshments at a Blue Lodge Meeting. You must obtain pre-approval and form from the Supreme Council Office.

An eight (8) foot tall display is available for MASONIC HOSPITALITY and other similar events where a large number of Masons are present.

Given the 2020 situation of Covid 19 and how it has impacted our Officers (at all levels) as well as Supreme, Association, and Grotto activities and conventions it causes for reflection. I chose to reflect and research the bylaws, rules, regulations and proceedings of how similar National emergencies impacted our organization and how it was handled. Joan and I visited your Supreme Council Office for reviewing the "PROPHETABLE IDEAS" (the early Grotto magazine) and the proceeding books and records of how this may have impacted the Grottoes of North America during the 1918 Spanish Flu, WWI, and WWII years.

To my surprise, very little was reported concerning a true relationship to the 1918 Spanish Flu years (1917-1919). It appears that the Grand Monarch of 1918-1919 continued to travel to Grotto and association events without interruption and both the 1918 and 1919 conventions proceeded as planned. The only reference to the illness (later known Spanish Flu) was in the Necrology Report for the 1919 convention in which it was recorded that the usual name list of deceased prophets of 1918-1919 would not be reported. This was reported as do to the large numbers of deceased prophets from the "Flu of the Fall 1918" and the losses of prophets serving in WWI. As I was discovering this Joan discovered an announcement in one of the 1945 issues of "PROPHETABLE IDEAS" reporting that the resolution passed at the 1943 Supreme Council Session would be activated thus cancelling the 1945 Supreme Council Convention as ordered by the ODT (OFFICE OF DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION - which only existed 7.5 year during the war). The Supreme Council was apparently informed prior to the 1943 convention that in the event the war continued for a prolonged period of time the ODT could and would stop travel to events such as conventions. Thus raising the question of how the business (and election) of the Supreme Council could and would be conducted. The proposed solution presented as a resolution at the 1943 convention, seconded and passed June 28th, 1943 at 2:00 pm was/is as follows:

"Be it resolved that if and whenever, in the opinion of the Grand Monarch, the Deputy Grand Monarch, the Grand Chief Justice, the Grand Master of Ceremonies, and the Grand Secretary, the present National War Emergency situation makes it impossible, impractical, or in any way contrary and averse to the national interest to hold an annual session of the Supreme Council, as prescribed by the Constitution, all the duties and powers ordinarily exercised by the Supreme Council shall be vested in and be exercised by a National Emergency Board, which shall be composed of the seventeen officers of the Supreme Council as listed in Article VII of the Constitution,

the Chairman of the Committee on Finance, and the Chairman of the Committee on Jurisprudence and Laws.

The acts of this board in such circumstances shall be of the same force and effect as if done by the Supreme Council itself except:

- (1) It shall not have the power to amend, alter, or change the Constitution or the by-laws and general regulations of the Supreme Council.
- (2) Its power to elect officers of the Supreme Council shall be limited to:
 - (a) Re-electing the Grand Secretary, the Grand Treasurer, and such Grand Trustees whose terms shall have expired (except in case of death or inability to serve) when they shall have full power of section and election.
 - (b) Electing the other officers by advancing them in line, the office or officers thus becoming vacant at the foot of the line to remain so until the next full and regular session of the Supreme Council shall have been held.

A full and regular session of the Supreme Council shall be called at a time and place selected by the said national Emergency Board within twelve months after the present National War Emergency is terminated by proclamation of the federal government."

As a Past Grand Monarch I had never heard of this (and as you are now asking yourselves) and is not printed in the Supreme Council Code book. This information was discussed with Executive Secretary and copies sent to the Grand Monarch, Deputy Grand Monarch, and chairman of the J&L committee for review and possible use (if needed) and possible addition to the current code book.

Thank you to our wonderful Supreme Council Office staff for their help and assistance in accessing the archives and office equipment for coping and preparing for mailing. Special thanks to my wife Joan for her co-researching and willingness to give up a day of vacation to complete our mission. I'm not sure that without her I would have found the resolution, since surprisingly the "PROPHETABLE IDEAS" article gave date and page of the resolution in the proceedings book. Hats off to the Supreme Council of 1943 for the wisdom to address a possible problem before it happened.

At a time when the value of history is being questioned I found this experience a fine example of why history is so important and why we keep the old proceedings books and archives.

In 1934, soon after Hitler's rise to power, it became evident that Freemasonry was in grave danger. Realizing this danger, the Freemasons went undercover and adopted a little blue flower, the Forget-Me-Not, to replace the Square and Compasses as the symbol whereby the Brethren could identify each other in public as well as in the concentration camps of Europe. In 1948, when Lodges reopened following World War II, this became the official Masonic emblem in honor of the valiant Brethren who carried on their Masonic work under very adverse conditions.

Zafar: Meaning "victory" or "triumph"

Zal: In Moore's tale, he was a young Persian and celebrated hero. He came at night to see his

Rodahval, who let down long tresses to assist him in his assent. He, however, managed it

in the less romantic way of hooking his arm over a projecting beam.
