- 2. The Web Page Contest will be the Best Web Page by a Grotto or Association. The rules for this contest are available from the Supreme Council Office and entries should be received by June 10, 2022, to give the Judges time to review and judge the web sites before they leave home for the Convention.
- 3. An award certificate will be presented to the winners at the Awards Ceremony on Saturday evening. After the Supreme Council Office personnel return home, they will prepare

the checks and send them to the winning contestants and units.

- 4. The Themed Hospitality Room Contest will be held on Wednesday night, <u>July 6, 2022</u>, following the Grand Opening. This year's theme will be "A Day in Time." The rules for this contest are available from the Supreme Council Office. It should be noted that the registration forms for this contest must also be in the Supreme Council Office by <u>June 10, 2022</u>.

GRAND HISTORIAN'S CORNER

I have heard that there once was a Grotto in Cuba. Since we now have Grottoes in Puerto Rico and El Salvador I thought it might be time to learn about the Grotto that was in Cuba. During our vacation in September, Joan and I visited the Supreme Council to get more information on it. We looked in the roster books and couldn't find any listings for it. Pat Phillips, Administrative Assistant, also helped us. We could not find any Grotto from Cuba. While I was Grand Monarch, Bill Thomas Past Grand Master of NY mentioned it several times so I gave him a call. The Grotto's name was El Morro in Havana, Cuba. Once we had a name, the rest came fairly quickly.

El Morro was instituted on November 8, 1952. Charted in 1953. In December of 1953 the Grand Monarch appointed Prophet Cosme Alonso Yanes, Secretary of El Morro, to investigate the possibilities of creating Grottoes in Dominican Republic, Caracus, Venezuela, Mexico City, Puerto Rico, South America and Lima, Peru.

In the procedure book of 1954 "On September 19, 1953 I (Grand Monarch John Nicklas Jr.) constituted El Morro Grotto at Havana, Cuba. This event requires special note because it is a significant milestone in the life of the Mystic Order of Veiled Prophets of the Enchanted Realm. El Morro Grotto is the first Grotto constituted outside of the Continental North America and in a Spanish-speaking country."

From Prophetable Idea March 1956. El Morro was a busy Grotto. In 1956, after the convention in New Orleans, a post-convention trip was planned at El Morro Grotto in Havana, Cuba. It was 850 miles from New Orleans to board a boat in Miami FL. The prophets of El Morro Grotto went all out to entertain those who took in the trip. A ceremonial (in Spanish) was also performed and is noted as it was "perfect in every respect." The Cuban Government issued two special stamps for the commemoration of the Grand Lodge of Cuba Building.

From Prophetable Idea September 1956. El Morro put an article in the publication that was written in both Spanish and English.

In July, 1955 El Morro wrote a letter to the Grand Secretary Otto Hildebrandt, P.G.M. concerning the Cuban flag and the Cuban National anthem. "...We felt extremely happy to see the flag of the Republic of Cuba displayed jointly with the flag of the United States and Canada on the stage ... However, we do expect that the number of Cuban flags borne and displayed by the Grottoes of our excellent Order in those countries at their official and public demonstrations will naturally increase as the understanding increases that our Order no longer is confined to the United States and Canada but has entered a new field which, although small, is fully responsive to the brotherly feelings of the Order." They also sent a number of copies of the Cuban National anthem.

In the 1961 and 1962 roster books, the "No information received" filled the space. By 1966 they were no longer listed.

HUMANITARIAN FOUNDATION



THE HISTORY OF THE HUMANITARIAN FOUNDATION

The Humanitarian Foundation, a 501c(3) nonprofit organization, is the official charity of the Grottoes of North America. Created in 1949 by the Supreme Council of the Grottoes of North America, the Foundation conducts the Dental Program for Special Needs Children for the Grottoes. The delegates at its Supreme Council Session in June 1949 adopted a resolution to establish a national charitable program that was named the HUMANITARIAN FOUNDATION.

Prophets (Grotto Members), family and friends are encouraged to help continue the work of the Foundation by supporting the Enchanted Lantern Society, Fairchild Society, and Legacy Society. All money donated is deposited into the Foundation trust, which only grants, interest and interest on investments are used each year. This ensures that every gift will continue to brighten children's smiles forever.

In 1951, their first project was "Aid for the Cerebral Palsy Child," from 1953 to 1970 the main thrust of the charitable thrust. In 1969 the Humanitarian Foundation Trustees, realizing that the momentum from the 1950s to 1960s, expanded their scope by adopting the Dentistry for the Handicapped child. In 1969, they met and agreed the Grotto would establish a dental clinic for the handicapped child at Illinois Masonic Medical Center.

In 1973, the Extension Program of the Dentistry for the Handicapped Child began, when the Trustees realized many children who did not live in the Chicago area could be treated locally and at less cost, without the burden of traveling and housing for the parent and child.

The program is now designed to help special children under the age of 18 receive the best dental care possible. Today, the Humanitarian Foundation has a unique partnership with qualified dentists throughout the United States and Canada.



THE HISTORY OF THE ENCHANTED LANTERN

In the early days of Masonry and the Grotto, the owner of a local business would hang his type of lantern in front of his store to notify of a meeting that night. For the Grotto, the Enchanted Lantern signifies a "Beacon of Hope" for Children with Special Needs. The history of the lantern was not forgotten when, in 1953, the Grottoes adopted the "Enchanted Lantern" as their emblem to represent each contribution of \$50 or more.

The annual sale of Enchanted Lanterns to Grotto members, family and friends through the Enchanted Lantern program and Gifts, Wills and Bequests Programs. The Gifts, Wills and Bequests Programs handle the gifts and estate contributions given by members, family and friends, who wish to continue helping these "special children" long after they are gone. With the Enchanted Lantern Program and the Gifts, Wills and Bequests, it is our hope the Foundation will grow even larger, so we can continue to help put smiles on the faces of these "special children."
